Order of the Arrow Representative

General Information

Type -	Apply to Scoutmaster
Term -	6 months
Reports to -	Assistant Senior Patrol Leader and Scoutmaster
Description -	The OA Representative is the youth liaison between the troop and the Order of the Arrow (OA) lodge or chapter
Comments -	The OA Rep coordinates service opportunities, unit elections, camp promotions and inductions within the unit with the local OA lodge.

Qualifications

Must be a registered member of the OA in good standing with both the lodge and the troop.

Age -	13
Rank -	1 st class
Experience -	Scouting Skills
Attendance -	Must have had attendance of 50% in the previous 12 months

Performance requirements

Training -	One day JLT
Attendance -	You are expected to attend 75% of all troop meetings, Patrol Leaders Meetings, outings, campouts and service projects. This includes OA events and monthly meetings. If your attendance is low, or if you have 3 unexcused absences in a row, you can be removed from this position.
Effort -	You are expected to give this position your best effort.

General leadership responsibilities

Uniform -	Set the example by wearing the full scout uniform correctly, including your OA sash.
Behavior -	Set the example by living the scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show scout spirit in everything you say and do.
Attendance -	Set an example by being an active scout. Be on time for meetings and activities. You must call the senior patrol leader if you are going to be absent for an outing and attempt to find someone to assume your responsibilities.

Specific leadership responsibilities

- Serves as a communication link between the OA lodge and the troop
- Encourages year round and resident camping in the troop
- Encourages older scout participation in high adventure programs
- Encourages scouts to actively participate in community service projects
- Assist with leadership training in the troop
- Encourages Arrowmen in the troop to be active in the OA and to seal their membership in the order by becoming Brotherhood members.
