Chaplain's Aid

General Information

- Type - Apply to Troop Chaplain and /or Scoutmaster
Term - 6 months
Reports to - Troop Chaplain
Description - The Chaplain Aide works with the troop Chaplain to meet the religious needs of the Scouts in the troop. He also works to promote the religious awards program.
Comments - Duty to God is one of the core beliefs in Scouting. The Chaplain Aide helps everyone in the troop by preparing short religious observations for campouts and other functions. The Chaplain Aide does not always lead the observation himself and can have other help from troop members.

Qualifications

- Age - none
Rank - 1st Class
Experience - none
Attendance - Must have had attendance of 50% in the previous 12 months

Performance requirements

- Training - Attend troop Junior Leader Training
Attendance - You are expected to attend 75% of all troop meetings, Patrol Leaders Meetings, outings, and service projects. You must attend 90% of all campouts. If your attendance is low, or if you have 3 unexcused absences in a row, you can be removed from this position.
Effort - You are expected to give this position your best effort.

General leadership responsibilities

- Uniform - Set the example by wearing the full scout uniform correctly.
Behavior - Set the example by living the scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show scout spirit in everything you say and do.
Attendance - Set an example by being an active scout. Be on time for meetings and activities. You must call the senior patrol leader if you are going to be absent for an outing and attempt to find someone to assume your responsibilities.

Specific leadership responsibilities

- Assist the troop Chaplain with religious services at troop activities
- Tells scouts about the religious emblem program for their faith
- Make sure grace is said at every meal
- Makes sure religious holidays are observed during troop planning
